Submission of a signed declaration accepting the following criteria:

Compliant with KEY BC Traffic Laws and Driving Regulations as noted below:

- National Safety Code number
 - Passenger Transportation number (displayed on every vehicle)
 - Liability insurance (\$5,000,000)
 - Proper ICBC insurance on all vehicles (\$5,000,000)
 - Commercial Vehicle Inspection every 6 months on all vehicles

- Compliant with applicable Municipal Licenses
- Food Safe Level 1 Certification if handling food on tours
- Guides request that guests who appear under the age of 25 present photo Identification, prior to commencement of tour
- Guides do not consume alcoholic beverages while on tour with guests
- Guests are not required to drive their own vehicle, under the influence of alcohol, at the conclusion of the tour
- Tour Vehicles provide appropriate accommodation for guest comfort
- The company must be in operation for a full calendar year from date of their appropriate licenses prior to applying to be a member
- Positive and professional reputation with wineries, hotels, other venues and other operators.
- All information and promotional materials including websites, advertising, and signage are an accurate reflection of the company.

Failure to comply with any of the above noted criteria will result in a review by the Board of Directors of the association that may result in a suspension or the termination of membership.
